

Job Description: Music Resident

Cliff Temple Baptist Church is seeking a Music Resident to lead the congregation in intergenerational worship. The Worship Residency Program is a two-year program designed to give worship leaders an opportunity to gain invaluable skills and experience essential for growth in vocational ministry. Cliff Temple is a congregation steeped in tradition and innovation. Our Sunday worship reflects both old and new songs featuring, choir, organ, piano, percussion, bass and guitar along with monthly nights of prayer and worship that are freer in form.

Position Reports To: Minister for Music and Worship

Hours: Part-time, 20+ hours per week, with flexible scheduling

Education: Minimum bachelor's degree in music; Master of Divinity or Master of Church Music is preferred, but not required.

Experience: Three years of worship leading experience preferred, a passion to work and grow the mission of the church to build everyday people into everyday missionaries for Jesus Christ.

- A personal, observable relationship with Jesus Christ, and a sense of calling from God to serve the church.
- A lifestyle that reflects and models spiritual maturity in Christ, Christian ethics, personal morality, and the core values of Cliff Temple Baptist Church.
- A giftedness musically to lead worship with prayerful attentiveness to the moment; able to navigate the balance between administrating a thoughtful and well-planned worship with times that are unplanned.
- Ability to oversee a dynamic and diversified worship ministry that is committed to a hybrid approach of ancient and future, old and new.
- Ability to work with sound and A/V equipment, ProPresenter, and current technology.
- Commitment to continuing education and growth through reading, attending conferences, formal classwork, and other professional development opportunities.
- Personality gifts that relate effectively to the whole congregation.
- Giftedness in leadership, recruitment, and organizational management.
- Openness to creativity in worship ministry.

Primary Responsibilities

- Serve as an apprentice to the Minister for Music and Worship.
- Work with the pastoral staff to develop an integrated worship ministry.
- Regular worship leadership based on interest in growth areas.
- Help plan and execute services, serving as principal worship leader on Sunday mornings once per month and as the catalyst for Wednesday prayer and worship gatherings once per month.
- Work with staff and musicians across the church to ensure accurate reflection of Spanish language music for the benefit of the congregation.
- Participate in the wide range of Cliff Temple ministries that relate to the broader Oak Cliff community.

Compensation

- Residents will be considered Part-Time employees of Cliff Temple Baptist Church and will be given a generous half-time stipend to help offset living expenses.
- This is a half-time 2-year staff position subject to growth with the growth of the ministry.
- Performance will be evaluated annually after a 6 month close guidance period. Performance will be evaluated based on this job description and a separate annual review process.
